Inspiring Minds seeks early childhood educators to support our transition to Kindergarten Program. The early childhood educator will support a Kindergarten teacher in creating a warm and nurturing relationship with each child, designing an environment that stimulates curiosity, and utilizing a dynamic curriculum that is grounded in hands-on exploration and play in our six-week transition to kindergarten program at one of four Providence Elementary Schools.

In addition to assisting the Kindergarten teacher in the classroom, the early childhood educator will be responsible for the pre-service curriculum preparation and will be the coordinator of the administrative duties at the site during non-teaching hours.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Applicants must have a RI Department of Education teacher certification in Early Childhood Education (ECE) or
- Bachelor in Early Childhood Education with 3 months supervised teaching experience in an ECE setting.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Applicant has RIELDS Foundations and Developing a Standards-Based Curriculum certificates.
- Applicant is bilingual, English and Spanish.
- Applicant has state-funded pre-k experience.

This position is temporary, with training to be scheduled in June. Program is July 8, 2019 through August 16, 2019 hours are 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Monday- Friday. Planning hours are flexible between April and June.
